Caoyang Xincun 曹杨新村

Caoyang Xincun is a workers' residential district located in Putuo District, Shanghai. It comprises nine residential quarters, known as Caoyang Yicun (No.1 Village) to Cao Yang Jiucun (No.9 Village). Initially constructed in 1951, it was the first workers' new village in Shanghai and indeed in all of China.

Centennial Park 百禧公园

Originally a railway market, the 1-kilometer-long Centennial Park was redeveloped in 2021 into a multi-level, composite community park, providing space for sports and social interaction for local residents.

Caoyang Park 曹杨公园

Opened on May 1st, 1954, Caoyang Park was the first park established within a workers' new village in Shanghai. In 2018, the park was revitalized with the reconstruction of its original tea house and the addition of new rest facilities, infusing it with renewed vitality for the contemporary era.

Caoyang Ring Creek 曹杨环浜

The Ring Creek is a 2.14-kilometer-long looped residential waterway within Cao Yang New Village. It connects historical spaces such as Cao Yang Yi Cun, the Red Bridge, and Caoyang Park, serving as a crucial blue-green corridor for the community.

Caoyang Yicun 曹杨一村

Built in 1951, Cao Yang Yi Cun was the first workers' new village of New China. It was designated as a Shanghai Outstanding Historical Building (4th batch) in 2004 and listed among the "First Batch of Chinese 20th-Century Heritage" in 2016. In 2021, the village underwent a comprehensive renovation that significantly improved living conditions in the old residential area while preserving its historical architecture.

Gui Xiang Fang 桂巷坊

Located in the eastern section of Gui Xiang Road within Cao Yang New Village, Gui Xiang Fang includes the Gui Xiang Commercial Pedestrian Street and Gui Xiang Market. It serves as a primary venue for the daily shopping needs of local residents.

Caoyang Community Cultural Center 社会文化中心

The Caoyang Community Cultural Center was the first community cultural activity center in Putuo District. It houses a variety of learning spaces, including a library, children's classrooms, a digital reading room, and a baking studio.

Caoyang Community History Museum 曹杨新村村史馆

The Community History Museum is a Shanghai Patriotic Education Base. It documents the developmental history of Cao Yang New Village from its establishment in 1952 to the present day.
